1. For and on behalf of the Governor of Meghalaya, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Meghalaya, Shillong (hereinafter called as the 'PCCF') invites sealed tenders for supply of following equipments conforming to the detailed specifications indicated in the schedule-I:

2. Obtaining of Tender Form

- (a) Tender booklet containing detailed specifications of the equipments to be supplied along with terms and conditions may be obtained from the Conservator of Forests (T & Dev.) at the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Sylvan House, Lower Lachumiere, Shillong 793 001, Meghalaya on payment of Rs.100 either in cash or by crossed Bank Draft / Pay Order payable to the Conservator of Forests (T & Dev.). Fee of tender form is not refundable.
- (b) Alternatively the complete set of tender forms can be downloaded from the official web site of the Meghalaya Forest Department at megforest.gov.in. All tenders submitted on the tender document downloaded from the website shall be enclosed with non-refundable demand draft for an amount of Rs. 100 (rupees one hundred) only drawn in favour of the Conservator of Forests (T & Dev.), Meghalaya, Shillong payable at Shillong being the cost of the tender document.

3. Qualification for Tendering

Original manufacturers or their authorized dealers/ agents and the firms and persons having past experience to supply at-least three similar equipments during last three years are qualified to submit the tender.

4. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- (a) Each tender shall be accompanied with refundable Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) as mentioned in the para 1 above, in the form of crossed demand draft or pay order from a scheduled commercial bank drawn in favour of the Conservator of Forests (T & Dev.), Meghalaya, Shillong payable at Shillong.
- (b) In case a tenderer quotes rates for more than one equipment, tenderer may submit EMD separately for each equipment or a consolidated EMD for all or any number of equipments for which rates have been quoted by him.
- (c) Tenders submitted without the prescribed EMD shall be summarily rejected.
- (d) On finalization of the tender, EMD submitted by all unsuccessful tenderers shall be returned forthwith. EMD furnished by the successful bidder shall be returned only after furnishing of the prescribed performance security.
- (e) If tenderer attempts to withdraw the tender submitted by him after its opening or fails to deposit prescribed performance security within a reasonable period, the EMD furnished by him shall be forfeited to the Government of Meghalaya free from all encumbrances.
- (f) No interest shall be payable on the EMD furnished by a tenderer.

5. Court Fee Stamp

- (b) In case rates are quoted for more than one model or make of particular equipment, highest rate shall be taken into account to calculate sum-total of the rates quoted for all the equipments.
- (c) Due to non-availability or any other reasons(s); if it is not feasible for the tenderer to affix non-judicial stamp of the prescribed denomination, the equivalent amount in-lieu thereof may be enclosed with the tender document in the form of crossed bank draft or pay order drawn from any scheduled commercial bank in favour of the Conservator of Forests (T & Dev.), Meghalaya payable at Shillong.
- (d) Tenders submitted without affixing the non-judicial court fee stamp or amount in lieu thereof is liable to be rejected summarily.

6. Performance Security

- (a) Successful tenderer(s) will be required to furnish performance security amounting to 5 % (five percent) of the total value of the equipment(s) to be supplied by him/them.
- (b) The performance security shall be furnished in the form of a demand draft or pay order or bank guarantee drawn in favour of the Conservator of Forests (T & Dev.), Meghalaya, Shillong from any scheduled commercial bank. In case the performance security is furnished in the form of a bank guarantee the same shall be valid for a period of at least one year from the date of installation of the equipment to be supplied by the successful bidder.
- (c) If a successful tenderer fails to supply the equipment(s) within the prescribed period or if the equipment supplied by the successful tenderer fails to perform satisfactorily within a period of one year from the date of its installation, the performance security submitted by the successful bidder may be forfeited to the revenue of the Government of Meghalaya free from all encumbrances.
- (d) No interest shall be payable on the performance security furnished by a tenderer.

7. Submission of Tender

- (a) Tender shall be filled in by making neatly typed or hand written appropriate entries in Part-I and Schedule-I- of the tender document by the tenderer himself or by a person duly authorised to submit and sign the tender on behalf of the tenderer, hereinafter referred to as the 'authorised signatory'.
- (b) All entries in the tender document shall be made in the English language only.

- (c) Overwriting in the tender document is strictly forbidden. Cutting and corrections in the tender, if any, should be attested by the authorised signatory by affixing his full signature along with date. The tenders containing non-attested over-written/ doubtful entries are liable to be rejected.
- (d) The tenderer shall quote a lump-sum price inclusive of all taxes, levies, packing, forwarding, insurance and installation charges up to the F.O.R. M/s. Marboh Bamboo Products Pvt. Limited, Near ICAR Research Complex, Umiam, Ri-Bhoi District, Meghalaya.
- (e) The rates quoted by the tenderer shall be valid for acceptance for a minimum period of six months from the date of the opening of the tender.
- (f) Conditional tenders are liable to be rejected summarily.
- (g) All pages of the tender document together with terms and conditions and the documents enclosed with the tender shall be signed by the authorised signatory. Acceptance signing of the tender form and the detailed terms and conditions shall be deemed as the final acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- (h) In the event of space on any page being insufficient for the required purpose, additional pages may be added. Each such additional page must be numbered consequently and be fully signed by the tenderer. In such cases' reference to the additional pages may be added in the covering letter.
- (i) A complete tender shall contain the following:

- (l) The tenderer should affix his full address on left bottom corner of the envelope containing the tender document.
- (m) The envelope containing the completed tender document shall reach to the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Sylvan House, Lower Lachumiere, Shillong 793 001 Meghalaya on or before the due date and time prescribed in the para 1 above. If desired, the tenderer may put the envelop containing tender directly in a Tender Box kept at the reception counter at the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Sylvan House, Lower Lachumiere, Shillong 793 001; Meghalaya. Immediately at the prescribed due date and time for the receipt of the tenders; the tender box will be sealed in the presence of the willing tenderers or their

representatives. In no case tenders received after due date and time shall be accepted and the PCCF or the Government of Meghalaya shall not be responsible for any delay in submission of a tender. All tenders received after the due date and time shall be returned to the respective tenderer without opening the same.

- (n) Due to any unavoidable reason(s), if the office of the PCCF remains closed on the date prescribed for opening of the tenders, the tenders will be received during the next working day at the same venue up-to the same time.

8. Opening of Tenders

- (a) Tenders shall be opened by an officer or a committee of officers duly authorised by the PCCF in this regard, in the presence of all willing tenderers or their representative duly authorised by them, at the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Sylvan House, Lower Lachumiere, Shillong-793 001, Meghalaya at 1.30 PM on 17.10.2008.
- (b) Due to any unavoidable reason(s); if office of the PCCF remains closed on the date prescribed for opening of the tender, the tenders shall be opened on the next working day without any change in the venue and time.
- (c) Following procedure shall be adopted for opening of tenders:
- Immediately after opening of the tender box, total number of tenders received and the name of tenderers will be announced to all the tenderers or their representatives present during the opening of the tenders and the same will also be entered in the tender opening minute register.
 - The sealed envelop containing the tenders will be opened one by one in the same order in which they have been entered in the tender opening minute register.
 - Immediately after opening the sealed cover each page of the tender document along with enclosures will be initialled by the officer or group of officers authorised by PCCF for opening of tenders and details of EMD, non-judicial court fee stamp or amount in lieu thereof; and the original money receipt in respect of the cost of tender document or amount in lieu thereof will be entered in the tender opening minute registers. All tenders received without prescribed EMD, court fee stamp or amount in lieu thereof and the original or a copy of money receipt for payment of the cost of tender document or amount in lieu thereof shall be summarily rejected with intimation to all the tenderers or their representative present during the opening of tenders.
 - After opening all the sealed covers the rates quoted by each valid tenderer shall be read out one by one.

9. Evaluation and Finalization of the Tenders

- (a) All valid tenders received shall be technically evaluated by a 'Technical Evaluation Committee' consisting of suitable officials having adequate technical knowledge, constituted by the PCCF.
- (b) The technical evaluation committee will thoroughly scrutinize and compare various specifications and features of the items offered by various tenderers with the desired specifications mentioned in schedule-I of the tender document and prepare a technical evaluation report clearly assigning rank in descending order to the valid offers for each item to be purchased.
- (c) On completion of the technical evaluation, all tenders along with comparative statement indicating rates quoted by each of the tenderer and report of the technical evaluation committee shall be placed before the competent tender accepting authority as prescribed in the Meghalaya (Delegation of Financial Powers) Rules, 1996 as amended from time to time for acceptance.
- (d) Keeping in view the technical specifications of the item offered to be supplied, rates quoted, past experience and any other information as it deem fit and proper; the concerned tender accepting authority may pass order as to the tenderer in whose favour order for supply of various items for which tenders have been called is to be placed.
- (e) The tenders are being called in anticipation of the receipt of the administrative approval and financial sanction from the concerned competent authority of the Government of Meghalaya. Procurement of the items included in the tender document is subject to receipt of requisite sanction as above. The PCCF and the concerned competent authority of the Government of Meghalaya reserve the right to accept or reject all or any tender, wholly or partially, without assigning any reason(s) thereof.
- (f) The PCCF or any of his superior authority of the Government of Meghalaya reserves the right to cancel or withdraw this tender notice at any time without assigning any reason(s) thereof.
- (g) Rates quoted by the tenderers shall remain valid for acceptance for a minimum period of six months from the date of the opening of the tenders. Any unsolicited correspondence by any tenderer after opening of tenders is liable to render the tender submitted by him as invalid.

10. Placement of the Supply Order

- (a) On receipt of the approval from the concerned competent authority, the PCCF or any of the officers authorised by him in this regard may place order in favour of the successful bidder requesting him to supply the equipment within a reasonable time to be clearly indicated therein.

- (b) In case the successful tenderer does not submit application for modification of the delivery date within seven days from the date of receipt of the supply order, he shall be deemed to have agreed to supply the equipment(s) within the delivery date stipulated therein.
- (c) The supply order shall also indicate the amount and last date for furnishing of the performance security in favour of the Conservator of the Forests (T & Dev.).

11. Making of Payment

- (a) The equipments must be supplied as per the specifications mentioned in tender document as well as in the supply orders. The PCCF reserves the right of non-acceptance of items, which are found not as per the prescribed specification.
- (b) The payments shall be made to the successful tenderers only after supply, successful installation and completion of the required performance related tests after making necessary deductions of all statutory taxes/ levies and penalty imposed by PCCF for late supply of the equipment, if any.
- (c) In case a successful tenderer fails to furnish the prescribed performance security, the same will be deducted from the amount payable to him.
- (d) Bank commission charged for demand draft will be borne by the successful tenderers and the same will be deducted from their payment.

12. Penalty for Non-Supply or Late Supply of Items

- (a) Unless extended by the PCCF' failure to supply the item(s) within the stipulated delivery period shall result in automatic cancellation of the order.
- (b) Extension of the period prescribed for delivery of items can be granted by PCCF in deserving cases without imposing any penalty. The decision based on valid evidence shall be taken on merits of the case
- (c) In case late supply of the item(s) is without any valid and cogent reason(s); the PCCF reserves the right to impose penalty up to a maximum of 4 % (four percent only) of the value of the supply order and he may deduct the same from the bills of the successful tenderer.
- (d) If the successful tenderer fails to supply the items on or before the prescribed last date' the PCCF also reserves the right to place order with the next higher tenderer and to forfeit EMD or performance security furnished by such defaulting tenderers to the revenue of the Government of Meghalaya free from all encumbrances and also to blacklist such defaulting tenderer.

13. Order For Additional Quantity

- (a) The PCCF reserves the right to place order on the successful tenderer at the same rate for an additional quantity, not being more than the quantity purchased through the first purchase order. Tenderers are bound to accept order for additional quantity under this clause only if the order is placed within six month from the date of issue of first purchase order.

14. Interpretation

- (a) In case of any dispute as to the interpretation of the above terms and conditions, the matter shall be referred to the PCCF, whose decision shall be final and binding.

1. Jaw Crusher

Desired Specifications: Supply, transportation, installation and commission of A 12 mm size single toggle type Jaw crusher having minimum capacity of 500 (five hundred only) kilograms per hour at a speed of app. 275 RPM. The Jaw crusher should consist of following components:

1. **Jaw Stock:** Heavy duty cast iron to hold the swinging jaw.
2. **Swing Jaw:** Made up of manganese steel. They should be replaceable and should also be able to be used both-ways.
3. **Check Plates:** For holding the fixed jaw and also to protect the main body.
4. **Fixed Jaw:** To be made up of manganese steel
5. **Toggle plate:** To impart rolling motion to jaw stock.
6. **Flywheel:** Made up of heavy duty cast iron to give momentum to the crusher
7. **Bearing:** Double row self aligning ball/ roller bearings fitted in jaw and main shaft in dust proof housings.
8. **Control Lever:** To adjust opening of jaws.
9. **Adjusting Block:** To impart forward and backward motion to jaw stock.
10. **Electric Motor:** Seven and half (7.50) HP capacity Crompton Greaves or equivalent make three phase induction motor to provide power to the crusher through pulley of suitable size or through 'V' groove machined on fly wheels along with 'V' belt etc. complete.

2. Impact Pulveriser

Desired Specifications: Supply, transportation, installation and commission of 32 Broad Chamber high speed, air swept, swing hammer type multi-purpose impact pulveriser having a capacity to pulverize approximately 900 kg/ hour charcoal to the fineness of 100 to 325 mesh. The pulveriser should consist of following parts:

- Automatic Feeder
- Built-in Whizzer Classifier
- Centrifugal Blower
- High Efficiency Cyclone Dust Collector

The pulveriser should be equipped with hopper along with a STAR FEEDER actuated by a Pawl and Ratchet mechanism. The fine grinding should be achieved by compression, shear, abrasion, attrition and impact of hammer on the materials against the replaceable striking plates. The pulverized product should be sucked by a strong suction blower and the result product should be carried by an air stream inside the mill. In between the fan and the hammers a whizzer, consisting of blades with tips tapered to conform to the whizzer cone should be provided. To reject the coarse materials to the grinding chamber for re-grinding; a counter current should be created at the periphery. Fineness should be controlled by clamping the whizzer clamp at a suitable position. The entire wearing portion consisting of Grinding Chamber and Whizzer Cone and Blower should be lined with replaceable lining plates.

The pulveriser should be provided with a high efficiency cyclone separator to separate the pulverized materials from air, which is re-circulated in the grinding chamber to complete the closed circuit grinding action. Inside the cyclone, dust laden gas should enter a cylindrical chamber tangentially and should leave through a central opening. The air path should form a vortex with air spiraling downward at outside and upward at inside. The excess air coming in the system with feed material, etc., should be bled off through a tubular static dust collector. The entire system should work under suction except the blower to cyclone pipe. The grinding chamber should be provided with a small pocket to act as a trap for small pieces of iron, nuts and bolts etc.

The main driving shaft should run in two double rows self aligning heavy duty Ball or Roller bearings. The Pulveriser should be provided with an automatic feeder to ensure regular and regulated feeding.

Pulveriser should be provide with a fifty (50) HP capacity Crompton Greaves or equivalent make three phase induction motor to provide power to the crusher through pulley of suitable size.
